

## DRIVING RANGE TERMS & CONDITIONS

## LIABILITY

- 1. Whittlebury Park does not accept any liability for loss or damage to any personal possessions or golf equipment. Please do not leave items unattended.
- 2. All players must have adequate personal golf insurance.

## **PLAY**

- 1. Players should familiarise themselves with the warning notice displayed on the bay dividers in every bay.
- 2. Only one player is allowed in the bay at any time. Guests should stay behind the bench out of the bay when a player is in swing. Whittlebury Park does not accept responsibility for any injury caused whilst on the driving range. Guests are responsible for their own safety and that of others.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the player to aim centrally down the range towards the target greens. Players should not aim towards the netting at the back of the range or the grass bank that runs along the left-hand side of the range. Mats should be re-aligned if necessary before starting your session.
- 4. Balls must be hit from the driving range mats only, and under no circumstances from the grass bank.
- 5. If you hit a ball outside of the perimeters of the range, please shout "FORE".
- 6. Balls should not be collected from the grass or stoned area in front of the bay under any circumstances.
- 7. Players under the age of 13 must be supervised by an adult.

## **ETIQUETTE**

- 1. Players are accountable for any damages to the driving range, including monitors, mats, dividers, lighting and any other equipment or fittings. This list is not exhaustive. Whittlebury Park reserves the right to invoice players for any damages caused.
- 2. Players should be courteous to others, including staff, when using the driving range. The use of foul and abusive/offensive language will not be tolerated.
